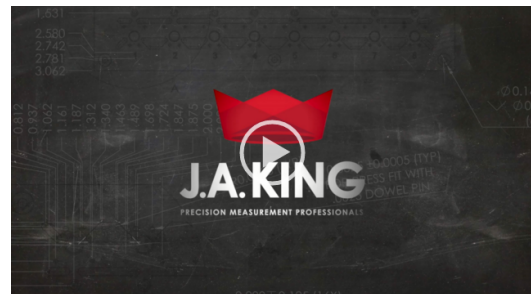

DO YOU KNOW WHERE ALL YOUR GAGES ARE? ARE THEY CALIBRATED?

The first step in preparing for a successful audit typically involves a tool sweep. During a tool sweep J.A. King technicians locate every piece of measurement equipment in your facility - from calipers, to scales, torque wrenches, and more. We then document its location so you can easily find it again during your audit. Most importantly, we verify every piece of equipment's calibration status. Typically, we then calibrate any items that are found to be past due to ensure everything is current for the auditor.

A tool sweep ensures you have a solid foundation heading into your audit. Other benefits include:

- Locate missing gages that therefore don't need to be replaced
- No audit findings for past due gages in use
- Updating your system to reflect what is on the plant floor

At the end of your tool sweep you are furnished with a comprehensive report featuring the number of gages found during the sweep, the number of gages that were non-conforming including those that were overdue for calibration, not listed in your asset management system, or those that had never been calibrated, a comparison of what was listed in your asset management system versus what was actually on the plant floor, and any further recommendations to avoid audit findings or improve asset management.
